The 2011/12 season is nearing completion. Well done and thanks to all of the coaches, managers, committees, parents and especially the players on another enjoyable season.

On the playing front, some highlights include our under 15 South Dublin side being narrowly defeated in the All Ireland quarter final (a first for a South Dublin team). Presently they are winning the Premier Division . Our South Dublin Under 12 are league champions in the Division 1. Our under 14 DDSL Premier continue to play great football and are in contention for the league, league cup and are in the All Ireland semi finals. The under 8A and 9A's are competing well in the top tier, and our 11A are winning their league also. The 10B are league leaders with 13 B and 14B challenging for the league and the Under 17's are in cup final. The 16 Premier reached the cup semi finals and the under 15 girls have reached the cup semi final. Our Men's senior teams are going from strength to strength in the Leinster Senior League.

Templeogue United are delighted that we had a record number of players on the Under 14 DDSL panel with eight players in the squad that travelled to the UK to play Everton and Man City. The club also have players involved with the Ireland international under 15 squad and under 15s and 16s in the FAI emerging talent. Congrats to Killian Kinsella, Ben Rossiter and Dylan Baker who will represent the SDFL/NDSL selection to play the DDSL in the Aviva Stadium after the John Giles Walk of Dreams. We also have had a number of players visiting and trialling with UK premierships teams. One of these top Premiership teams is interested in putting on a coaching session hosted by us during the summer.

Congratulations to Niamh and Laura Lacey, Sarah Jane Hecker (u15) and Aisling Field and Saoirse Farrell (u13) who made it into the FAI girls emerging talent.

Much of the credit for our on the field success and player development goes to club coach Alan Kinsella who not only coaches the kids but holds seminars and regular sessions and forums for all club managers. Thanks also to Fred Davis our goalkeeping coach.
